WHAT IS A ROUNDABOUT?

A roundabout is a circular intersection in which traffic flows in one direction.

WHY A ROUNDABOUT?

A roundabout allows for better traffic flow, while reducing speeds and the chance of collisions.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Drivers entering a roundabout must reduce their speed to 30 km/h and yield to vehicles already in the circle.

Once in the roundabout, follow traffic signs and road markings to your exit.
